There is a proven risk that antibiotic residues could end up in milk or meat, which could cause food safety risks and regulatory problems. A withdrawal period for milk and meat of at least 2 days should be considered, according to several scientific studies.

It is produced at Intracare in hospital-grade cleanrooms to GMP Pharma standards and each production batch has a controlled release by a pharmacist.
